### Letters from Leah

January 4, 9:30ish....

The parking lot -- gorgeous. I would get out and dance in it, again, if it weren't so cold. Best pull in and get inside. But. Pay attention. You're going to have to train your muscle memory for new specs. Your parking spot got moved, and rightly so, when we redid the parking lot to make room for proper accessible parking spots.

Wonder what people must think when they walk in this door to find themselves in the middle of a food pantry.... a food pantry anchored by those in-your-face theological posters. Who knows what they think – what they should see is a church living its values. This space has always been so empty, and frankly, not usable for much. But here it is serving a purpose for which it was made, a purpose which the people who came before us would've never imagined. Good job, church. Good job Holy Spirit. And look at that: two racks of coats waiting for our Jubilee guests. I've wondered about our guests while I was away.... about J and B and the others who have no permanent address. It's gotten cold and it will only get colder. I'll be glad to see everyone again on Monday night.

I've wondered about this, too.... laughed about it, out loud, one random night in November. Would my "Moses come back!" word bubble that I affixed to the elevator sign disappear while I was away? Glad to see the answer is: no. That little fire always looks like the burning bush to me. Grateful, always, to serve a church that isn't so stuffy.

What's that.... a collection box for supplies for refugees. That's new, but not surprise. Not really. Again, good on you, church.

"Good morning, Leah! Welcome back!" Carla's greeting is like a little ray of sunshine on this gray day. I am so grateful we found her, just in the nick of time.... before covid.... before my sabbatical. Again, good job, Holy Spirit. I ought to believe what I say when I say, "Kairos over Chronos," a little more often.

My office looks just how I left it, after the big clean. Hello, Mary, still smiling serenely, full of promise. Hello, peace cranes, still swirling above my head. Hello, Daryl, still standing there in the corner – a life-size reminder of the way being loved in community can help heal a broken life. Hello, office, still the color of sunshine and the sky. I missed you.

"Did you hear about....? Do you know about....?"

"I know nothing, really. People were very respectful of my sabbatical space. No, I don't know about that. Nor that. Nothing, really. Tell me."

"Have you seen the parlor?"

"I have not. Is it...? done?"

I wondered if this would happen, if I would return to a new gathering space, a new parlor, a new church family living room. Duck through the sanctuary, first, though. I've missed that sacred space.

Oh, hello epiphany stars. You help us hold onto a little Christmas light on through the winter. Hello, tech station, you

The liturgist leads portions of the worship service including reading the scripture lesson. All information is sent ahead of time so there is time to practice before the worship service.

The role of the greeter is to welcome folks as they arrive for the worship service and assist them in finding their way around the building.

The usher escorts folks into the sanctuary and ensure they are seated socially distanced from the group sitting in the pew in front and behind them. Directions are provided. Ushers also count and record the physical number of people attending a worship service.

For dessert, guests had their choice of housemade rice pudding, housemade spicy Mexican chocolate bread pudding, or apple pie. Just when we thought we were done for the night, another person came. And another. And another. And another. We were still serving well past closing time, while volunteers were tearing down and putting things away. One of our regular community folks was on a bus that was running late. He came anyway, knowing we would still be cleaning up, in hopes he could get a meal for himself and two friends. Another student stopped by on his way home from class. His class got out late, but eating with Jubilee has been an important part of his week, now, for years. He didn't want to miss it. He came anyway.

Part of what makes Jubilee Cafe what it is the hospitality shown to every guest by every volunteer. This is especially true when you see how the parade of late comers was received this evening. Whether it was a regular student volunteer, Pastor Nate, or a CUCCer who met them at the door, each straggler was greeted warmly....yes, of course we still have food. What can we get you for dessert? Would you like anything else? Yes, we're cleaning up and, no worries, you were right on time. Life is hard these days. So many folks have talked with me about the weariness they feel. Perhaps if we all extended a little kindness, especially grace-filled kindness, the kind extended to our latest guests, we could get through this hard time and be a little better for it.

## Mission Ministry Team

WOW! CUCC – You’ve done some amazing work for Missions in the past year! Here’s a little summary of your accomplishments:

### Category 1: Donated and Used Money for Important Work

- Emergency Winter Appeal for Texas Freeze Assistance - \$895 + \$500 match from Mission Budget Money
- One Great Hour of Sharing - \$535
- Strengthen the Church - \$615
- Love Offering for the UP Center during PRIDE - \$578 + \$500 match from a family in the congregation
- Neighbors in Need - \$323
- The Christmas Fund - \$735
- Purchased a Community-Supported-Agriculture Share from Jubilee Farms from our Mission Budget Money
